WHAT IS INSTANT ACCESS?

Digital course materials are delivered to your blackboard course page on day one and charged on your student account. This way you get the content your instructor selected at drastically reduced prices. Often the digital materials include interactive learning tools, but sometimes the digital course material will be a standalone eBook with helpful study tools.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

- The instant access costs appear on your bill as “Bookstore Instant Access”
- You will receive an email at your ndus/bismarckstate email account explaining how to access the materials
- Look for a link to the online materials in blackboard
- If you drop the class during the add/drop period, no need to worry as charges do not appear until after add/drop date

- If for some reason you do not wish to obtain your course materials in this manner, you may choose not to. This option is referred to as “**opt-out.**”
- You can choose to opt out via a link in blackboard
- For the first week, you can opt out and opt back in as many times as you want while maintaining access. However, if the digital material is a standalone eBook, you will immediately lose access upon opting out, and would have to opt back in to regain access before the add/drop deadline.
